Assessments <u>not</u> included are MCA, MTAS, ACCESS, Alternate ACCESS, AP exams, ACT, Career Interest Inventories, NAEP, Special Ed and EL testing. Schools and Districts determine what constitutes a local assessment.

- \*\*\* High School MCA-III Science will be administered to all students completing Biology/Life Science credit in the current school year (grades 9-12).
- \*\*\*\* National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) is mandated and selected by the US Department of Education
